

DevEx's NSW Focus



A new copper-gold exploration opportunity in the premier Lachlan Fold Belt of NSW

- Exploration and investor resurgence in the Belt following recent drilling success such as Alkane Resources' Boda Prospect, Stavely Minerals Limited's Thursday's Gossan Prospect, and Sky Metals Limited's Hume Prospect
- DevEx holds +600km² of prospective tenure within the Lachlan Fold Belt
- Large-scale discovery potential in a district hosting several of Australia's largest copper-gold mines (Northparkes and Cadia-Ridgeway)


Walk-Up Drill Targets

- No prior drilling on projects for decades
- DevEx conducted a major exploration campaign in 2019, with results supporting historical data and upgrading high-priority targets
- Drilling underway in 2020 for a major porphyry copper-gold deposit

- Led by an invested and highly motivated team Chairman Tim Goyder is the largest Shareholder (~22% of DevEx)

- 1 Junior explorers riding a new wave of discoveries
- Alkane Resources³ (ASX: ALK) a single diamond drill hole indicated Cadia-style mineralisation and grade over hundreds of metres at the Boda prospect
- Stavely Minerals⁴ (ASX: SVY) discovery of shallow high-grade Cu-Au-Ag intersection at Thursday's Gossan prospect (Victoria)
- Sky Metals² (ASX: SKY) maiden drilling at its Hume prospect in NSW resulted in high-grade gold strikes with similarities to Regis Resources (ASX: RRL) McPhillamys Project

- As a result, no previous drilling within a globally-recognised copper-gold region for decades
- DevEx has now built a sizable ground holding across three, 100%-owned new projects
 - Junee Copper-Gold Project Bogong Copper-Gold Project
 - Basin Creek Gold Project (recently granted)

Junee Project: Exploring for a Cadia-Ridgeway style copper-gold discovery


- Dec 2017 Re-rating of the district with Government (GSNSW) mapping identifying porphyry monzonite intrusions contemporaneous with the Cu-Au bearing Northparkes and Cadia Ridgeway porphyry intrusions¹
- Junee Project underexplored with no exploration drilling for +25 years until 2020
- Large-scale with +20km of prospective strike
- DevEx's previous focus on securing Land Access, surface mapping and geophysical modelling - revealed porphyry Cu-Au type targets including:

Riversdale North: coincident IP anomaly underlying oxidised copper mineralisation and porphyry type alteration

Billabong Creek: distinctive magnetic low with associated IP anomaly and broad scale alteration.

Riversdale (West): new diamond hole intersects altered monzonite with magnetite and associated potassic alteration increasing down hole (extensive length seen in magnetics)

Nangus Road: prospective corridor south of Cooba Monzonite with close magnetic similarities




Junee Project: Exploration ramps up in 2020

1 Riversdale North Prospect

- 2019 assays and mapping identified oxidised copper associated with epidote veins and alteration, including a gold + base metal gossan assaying 2.81g/t Au, 0.4% Cu and 1.3% Pb
- **2020** a new, chargeability Induced Polarisation (IP) anomaly identified directly beneath this area

2 Billabong Creek Prospect

- 2020 A large 800m long chargeability IP anomaly identified on the eastern side of the magnetic/gravity low
- 2019 Mapping identified small occurrences of oxidised chalcopyrite (copper sulphide)-bearing breccia (rock chips ranging from 0.2% to 0.5% copper) immediately to the northwest and adjacent to a small quartz monzonite and diorite porphyry rocks exposed in a creek gully



Geophysics upgrades priority drill targets


Riversdale North Prospect

- Coincident IP chargeability anomaly near surface and directly beneath surface occurrences of scattered oxidised copper and gold mineralisation amongst porphyry type alteration
- · Drill hole planning underway


2 Billabong Creek Prospect

- 800m long IP chargeability anomaly shows close association with coincident magnetic low, which is flanked by silica-magnetite-heamatite altered rocks.
- Drill hole planning underway


Line 20,200mN - Chargeability Model (mV/V)

Planning now underway for drilling to test these upgraded targets




Nangus Road Prospect and surrounding targets




- Feb 2020: DevEx commences a ~60-hole air-core (AC) drilling programme testing the prospective fault corridor centred around the Nangus Road area.
- The fault corridor is considered highly prospective following Age dating and chemistry by the GSNSW in 2017 which identified the copper gold bearing monzonite at Cooba (located north of the Company's tenure) as high-potassium in nature and contemporaneous with the mineralised intrusions at Cadia-Ridgeway and Goonumbla (Northparkes)
- Jan 2020: Diamond hole at Riverdale West Prospect confirms the magnetic anomaly is associated with intrusive monzonite porphyry with porphyry copper-gold style alteration. 6km long system.
- Exploration for a more sulphide rich component of this intrusion the next step for Riversdale West



Bogong Project: Diamond drilling defines copper sulphide zone over +400m strike

- 2019 Drilling designed to test historical copper intercepts and newly identified IP anomalies
- Drilling intersects structurally controlled copper sulphide mineralisation (chalcopyrite and bornite) within and adjacent to a brecciated porphyry (diorite), extending over a strike length +400m
- Significant down-hole intercepts¹ include:
 - 19BGDD001 (Hole 1) 39.0m @ 0.5% Cu from 13m including: 12.6m @ 1.24% Cu
 - 19BGDD002 (Hole 2) 28.0m @ 0.6% Cu from 71m including: 6m @ 1.2% Cu
 - 19BGDD003 (Hole 3) 7.5m @ 0.9% Cu from 104.5m including: 2.5m @ 2.3% Cu

DevEx's Current Focus:

- Underexplored southern extension of copper zone where small diorites were observed
- Regional copper anomalies to the east overlying broad magnetic alteration

- Further investigation with mapping and soil geochemistry to determine the continuation of the copper mineralisation underway

Basin Creek Gold Project

- New gold opportunity with tenement granted in February 2020
- Currently compiling historical exploration from 1970-1980's
- Field investigation planned for this month
- New ground further strengthens DevEx's chance of discovery success in the Lachlan Fold Belt region, NSW
